On 01/27/2021 I made contact with via TX. is is identified on the Clinton County Dispatch CAD notes as a passerby/witness to a minivan doing donuts in the Dunkin Donuts parking lot during this incident. I spoke with over TX about what she had witnessed in the parking lot. The following is a summary of that conversation.

- advised that she arrived at the Dunkin Donuts at approx. 0700.
- She parked at the middle set of pumps facing the building (East).
- She got coffee, and while preparing to drive away she heard what she believed to be a loud vehicle and tires squealing.
- She observed a B/M driving a grey mini-van around the gas pumps "very reckless" and almost hit her.
- observed the van drive around the pumps twice.
- observed the driver yelling out the window while driving.
- advised that the van came close to hitting her vehicle and possibly another while driving circles in the lot.
- I asked if the van needed to be stopped by someone and she said "yes"
- then observed a red pick-up truck stop in front of the van and the truck driver exit.
- heard the drivers of both vehicles yelling at each other but could not make out what was being said.
- advised there was a lot of hostility in their voices
- advised that she believes she saw the driver of the truck point a gun at the driver of the van.
- then observed 2 marked patrol vehicles arrive on scene.
- then left the scene in her vehicle.
